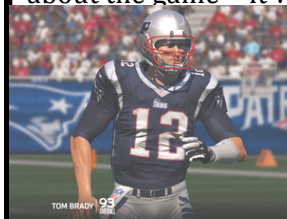


This December, witness the fantastic musical talent of the Anthony Wayne School Band. Conducted by the amazing Mrs.

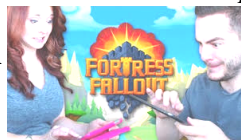

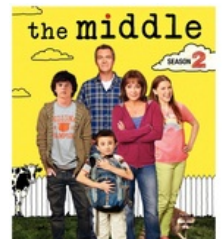

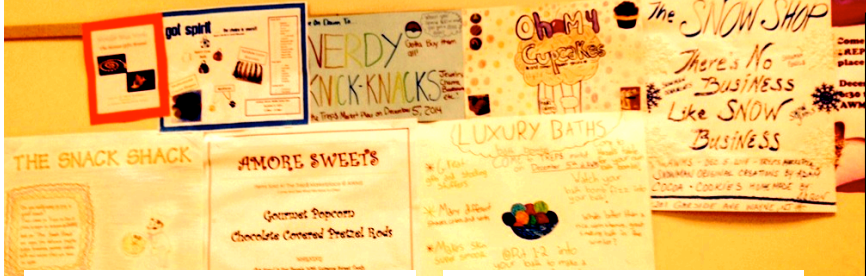
